

Jealousy/Envy

Proverbs 6.34 For jealousy is the rage of a man: therefore, he will not spare in the day of vengeance

Song of Solomon 8.6 Set me as a seal upon thine heart, as a seal upon thine arm: for love is strong as death; jealousy is cruel as the grave: the coals thereof are coals of fire, which hath a most vehement flame.

Proverbs 14.30 A sound heart is the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones

Mark 15.10 For he knew that the chief priests had delivered him for envy

Romans 13.3 Let us walk honestly, as in the day, not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying

Galatians 5.26 Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

James 3.14 and 16 But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.

I Corinthians 13.4-7 Love suffers long and is kind; love *envies not*; love vaunts not itself, is not puffed up, Does not behave itself unseemly, seeks not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil, Rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; Bears all things, believeth all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

Romans 13.10 Love works no ill to his neighbour: therefore, love is the fulfilling of the law
