Luke 11.1 2-4 "Lord, teach us to pray",When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Give us day by day our daily bread. And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.

Philippians 4 6-7 Be anxious for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 5.18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all of God's people.

James 5 16-18 The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. Elijah was a human being subject to feelings as we are, and he prayed earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit.

Matthew 7 7-8 11 Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asks receives and he that seeks finds and to him that knocks it shall be opened how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?
